Admission Requirements: **3.0 or greater grade point average** on a 4.0 scale with a grade of "C" or better in all PTA program prerequisite courses. GPA points calculated for program selection will be on the program prerequisite course requirements only. Students who have successfully completed all the program prerequisite course requirements will be considered for admission first. Students who have not completed all PTA program prerequisite courses will be considered thereafter only if space is available and provided that submitted documentation reflects that the program prerequisite course requirements will be successfully completed prior to the program start date.
